Ivy Play in Full Swing

- It's time for the Friday-Saturday grind in the Ivy League, and Dartmouth begins with the longest league trip, going to Cornell (which has an RPI rating of 37) on Friday, then Columbia on Saturday.
- The Big Green were swept on this trip last year, but not without a fight against Cornell, taking the eventual Ivy champs to double overtime after rallying from a 19-point deficit.
- Dartmouth made a valiant effort in an upset bid against Harvard last Saturday, but came up four points short in a 62-58 loss in Leede Arena.
- Junior **Ronnie Dixon** had a season-high 15 points against the Crimson with a trio of three-pointers, while senior **Robby Pride** tallied 13 and sophomore **Jabari Trotter** had 12 off the bench.
- The star of the game for the Big Green, however, was their defense, holding Harvard 15 points under its scoring average and to a 39.0 percent shooting night; the Crimson entered the game ranked sixth nationally in field goal percentage.
- **Pride** has been on a scoring binge of late, averaging 17.0 points in the last two contests, including a career-high 21 in the win over St. Francis (N.Y.).
- As a team, Dartmouth's shooting has improved since the new year began, clipping the nets at a 42.6 percent rate and topping 40 percent in three of the four games. In the first 12 contests, the Green shot just 38.4 percent and at least 40 percent just twice.

Series vs. Cornell (16-3, 2-0)

- Despite the Big Red's success against Dartmouth of late, winning 11 of the last 12 meetings, the Big Green still own the all-time advantage at 101-97, making this their most-often played series.
- The Big Red have won the last eight games in the series, with the last Dartmouth victory coming in Leede Arena on Feb. 19, 2005, 67-54.
- The Big Green are 7-13 versus Cornell in Newman Arena, having lost the last six after winning five straight here.

Scouting the Big Red

- The unanimous choice to defend its Ivy title, Cornell enters this game with a record of 16-3 overall and 2-0 in the league having beaten Columbia twice by a combined total of 47 points.
- The Big Red received 38 points in the coaches poll this week, making them the second team outside the top 25.
- Only teams from the Big East (Seton Hall, Syracuse) and the Big 12 (Kansas) have defeated Cornell. The Jayhawks barely escaped with a five-point victory on their home court three weeks ago.
- The senior trio of forward Ryan Wittman, center Jeff Foote and guard Louis Dale average more than 41 points a game, with Wittman second in the Ivy League at 18.2 points.
- Foote is not only the league's top rebounder by far at 8.6 per game, he is also the second-most accurate shooter at 59.1 percent and would be among the top 10 nationally if he had one more field goal.
- Strength against strength — Cornell is fourth nationally in three-point percentage (.419), while Dartmouth is 14th in three-point defense (.288).
- Wittman easily leads the conference in three-pointers with 62. The closest competitor has 39. Guards Chris Wroblewski (32) and Geoff Reeves (30) also rank among the league's top 10.

INTERIM HEAD COACH MARK GRAUPE



Mark Graupe was officially named Dartmouth's interim head coach on Jan. 14 after guiding the team in a 76-47 loss to Harvard on Jan. 9, one day following Terry Dunn's resignation.

Graupe (pronounced GRAUW-pee) joined the Big Green as an assistant

coach over the summer in preparation for the 2009-10 season. Graupe was on the staff at Colorado State in 2008-09 and has more than 20 years of coaching experience.

Before Colorado State, Graupe spent seven strong seasons as the head coach at Lake Region State College (N.D.) where he posted an overall record of 126-95 (.570). In both 2007 and 2008, he guided Lake Region to the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Region 13 title, earning regional coach of the year honors in both campaigns. Seven of his players went on to play at the NCAA Division I level at places like Binghamton, Jackson State, North Dakota and Southern, and three earned NJCAA All-America status.

Graupe also spent two seasons coaching boys basketball at Williston High School, four at Devils Lake High School and six at Unity High School, all in North Dakota. During three of his six years at Unity, he also coached the girls team.

A native of Crosby, N.D., Graupe earned his undergraduate degree in physical education and mathematics from the University of North Dakota in 1987, then earned his master's in kinesiology from UND in 2004. After his final season at Lake Region, he was presented by his alma mater with the Thomas J. Clifford Award for excellence in the coaching profession.

Series vs. Columbia (6-10, 0-2)

- This is the 197th game in the series with the Lions holding a 102-94 advantage all-time.
- Dartmouth has gone 15-20 in Columbia's Levien Gymnasium since it opened in 1974.
- Last year the two teams held serve at home with the Lions taking a 65-52 game here and the Big Green winning in Leede Arena, 67-53.
- The last 26 encounters have been split evenly, dating back to the 1996-97 season.

Scouting the Lions

- Since a promising 5-4 start, Columbia has dropped six of its last seven, including its first two Ivy League games to the favorite, Cornell.
- Dartmouth and Columbia have had four common opponents entering the weekend: Bucknell at home (wins for both), Quinnipiac on the road (losses for both), St. Francis (N.Y.) at home (Dartmouth won, Columbia lost) and Lehigh (Columbia won at home, Dartmouth lost on the road).
- Like Cornell, the Lions are an excellent shooting team from the perimeter, ranking fifth nationally in three-point percentage (.417).
- But in the last three games, Columbia's sights have been off, hitting just 12-of-48 (.250) behind the arc. Predictably, the Lions have not scored more than 53 points in any of those contests.
- Noruwa Agho is deadly from downtown, shooting 54.2 percent, and he is the only Lion averaging double figures in points at 16.8.
- The Dartmouth defense also will have to be wary of Niko Scott, who has 23 treys and hits them at a 42.1 percent clip.
- Forwards Brian Grimes and Asenso Ampim lead the team in rebounding at 6.4 and 5.2 per game, respectively.

Almost Famous

Dartmouth has not played a ranked team in more than three years, but Cornell is awfully close at 27th in the coaches poll. The last ranked team to play against the Big Green was fifth-ranked Kansas on Nov. 28, 2006. Whenever Dartmouth gets another opportunity against a top 25 squad, it will do so with the goal of breaking a 39-game losing streak against them. The Green are 3-49 all-time versus ranked teams, with the last two wins coming in the 1955-56 season.

Shooting Improving

Over the first 12 games, Dartmouth managed to shoot better than 40 percent from the floor just twice, winning both games. But in the last four contests, the Green have cracked the 40 percent barrier three times, losing only to Harvard by four points.

Dixon Has It In For Harvard

Last year, junior **Ronnie Dixon** missed just one game, and that was the overtime win at Harvard. To make up for his absence, the guard cranked up the production against the Crimson, leading the team with 12 and 15 points in the two games while shooting 11-of-21 (.524) from the floor, including 5-of-10 (.500) from long range.

Secure the Perimeter

If there is one thing Dartmouth does exceptionally well, it is perimeter defense. Opponents have struggled shooting three-pointers all season against the Big Green, and it shows in the stats. Dartmouth is 14th nationally in three-point percentage defense at a measly .288.

Graupe Gets First Win

Four days after being officially named the Dartmouth interim head coach, **Mark Graupe** guided the Big Green to a thrilling 65-64 victory over St. Francis (N.Y.). After building an early 14-point lead in the first half, the Green trailed for a majority of the second stanza. Dartmouth still trailed by four with 15 seconds left, but a **Robby Pride** three-point play with 10 seconds left and a **David Rufful** three-point play with less than a second on the clock lifted the Big Green to the exhilarating win.

Pride Puts Up the Points

Senior captain **Robby Pride** responded to the coaching change by lighting up the scoreboard against St. Francis (N.Y.) to the tune of a career-

high 21 points, hitting all but one shot all night. Not only did he can 6-of-7 from the floor (3-of-3 from beyond the arc), but also was a perfect 6-of-6 at the foul line, the most free throws he's ever sunk in a college game. To top it off, Pride picked up his fifth foul right after scoring his final three points, getting disqualified for the first time in his career.

One-Point Wonder

The 65-64 triumph over St. Francis (N.Y.) was the first one-point victory for the Big Green in over two years, since a 76-75 win against Vermont on Nov. 27, 2007. It was just the 11th one-point win for Dartmouth in Leede Arena since the facility opened for play 22 years ago. But the last three games played on the court have all been one-point Dartmouth victories — the women have won their last two home games by a single point as well. The only other time the two teams had combined for even two consecutive one-point wins in Leede Arena was in February of 1997 when the men beat Brown, 52-51, then the women followed with a 62-61 win over Princeton six days later.

Rufful Rides to the Rescue

Certainly people will remember the conventional three-point play pulled off by sophomore **David Rufful** with less than a second on the clock to beat St. Francis (N.Y.) by one, 65-64. But they should also remember a few other of his 16 points in the game, like his buzzer-beating 27-footer before the half, and his two free throws with 56 seconds to play to cut the deficit to two points. He and **Robby Pride** split the 14 Big Green points between them evenly during the final three minutes.

Free Throw Follies

Similar to the shooting woes from the floor, Dartmouth has managed to convert just 63.1 percent of its free throws, last among Ivy teams. But the Big Green's sights were aligned against St. Francis (N.Y.), nailing 16-of-21 (.762) from the charity stripe, just the fifth time the squad topped 70 percent in a game.

Freshman Frenzy

Offense has been in short supply this season for the Big Green, but freshman **R.J. Griffin** stepped up against Bucknell to lead Dartmouth to a 49-43 victory. The rookie sank 5-of-8 field goals, including 4-of-5 from downtown, to put up a season-high 16 points. On top of that, he hauled in a personal-best seven rebounds as well, doubling his total accrued in the first 12 games. Both the 16 points and the seven boards were nearly one-third of Dartmouth's total in the game (49 pts., 23 reb.).

New Game, New Scoring Leader

In the first 16 games, Dartmouth has had

no less than nine different players lead the team in scoring, more than any team in the country. Freshman **R.J. Griffin**, with his 16 points against Bucknell, is the most recent addition to the group. **Ronnie Dixon**, **Robby Pride** and **Jabari Trotter** have topped the Big Green three times, while **David Rufful** has done so twice.

What's Up Doc?

Dartmouth welcomed a new member to the sidelines on Jan. 14 when former Big Green assistant **Paul "Doc" Donohue** signed on to help the short-handed staff. He was a member of Paul Cormier's staff from 1985-91, then helped Dave Faucher in his first season at Dartmouth.

Head Coach Dunn Resigns

After five-and-a-half years, Terry Dunn resigned from his head coaching position on Jan. 8. During his tenure, he compiled a 47-103 (.313) record and a 25-45 (.357) mark against Ivy teams. Twice he led Dartmouth to 7-7 records in the conference, finishing as high as third in the league.

Defensive Shut Down

The Dartmouth defense was critical to the win over Bucknell, holding the Bison to a paltry 30.6 percent shooting for the game, the lowest for an opponent this year. The last Division I opponent to shoot as poorly came exactly four years ago to the day as the Green held Army to 29.2 percent on Jan. 4, 2006. The last team to score no more than 43 was Princeton on Feb. 23, 2007 in a 53-43 Dartmouth win. And the last time the Big Green won a game scoring less than 50 points was 13 days earlier in a 45-44 win at Princeton.

Trotter, Kouna Return to the Court

One good thing to happen at Quinnipiac on Dec. 30 was the return of sophomores **Jabari Trotter** and **Herve Kouna** to the floor for the Big Green. Trotter, who played a team-high 27 minutes in the game and is Dartmouth's leading scorer, had sat out the previous two games, while Kouna had missed five contests; both were due to injury.

Three Not So Magic for the Green

When Dartmouth failed to sink a single three-point attempt against Colgate, it ended a streak of 70 straight games with at least one trey. The last team to hold the Green without a three-ball was Brown on Feb. 17, 2007.

Ivy League Rookie of the Week

Freshman center **Matt LaBove** took home the league's Rookie of the Week award on Dec. 21 for his performances in losses at Lehigh and New Hampshire. First he posted a double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds, then scored nine points and grabbed six boards against UNH. He averaged 10.5 points and 8.5 rebounds while shooting 9-of-10 at the foul line. The last Big Green player to be the league's top rookie for a week was **David Rufful** last season on Feb. 23.

Rufful Has More Than Ridges

Sophomore **David Rufful** has had a rather up-and-down season (ridges, if you will), but peaked at New Hampshire with a career-high 18 points. The wing took 20 shots, connecting on eight, plus drained his only three-pointer and free throw of the day.

Tightening the Turnovers

Taking care of the basketball is a major point of emphasis, and it seems that point finally came across against UNH. In the first half, Dartmouth coughed the ball up just once, then finished the game with a season-low eight turnovers, its fewest since a 66-63 win at Princeton last Feb. 21. The Green nearly matched that total in the win over Bucknell, turning the ball over nine times for the game, and just twice in the first half.

LaBove LaDouble

At Lehigh on Dec. 17, freshman center **Matt LaBove** recorded his first career double-double, scoring 12 points while snaring 11 rebounds. The rookie was just 3-of-10 from the floor, but a perfect 6-of-6 from the foul line to account for his scoring. Eight of his season-high 11 boards came on the defensive end.

Taking Pride in Rebounding

Senior captain **Robby Pride** may be the shortest member of the team at six feet, but he proved he can collect some missed shots with a career-high nine rebounds at Lehigh. As a team, Dartmouth hauled in 43 boards, its most against a Division I team since grabbing that exact amount against Lehigh last year.

Trotter Taking Charge

In each of the first six games, a different Big Green player led the team in scoring outright. Against Army, one player finally took charge to lead the offense — sophomore **Jabari Trotter**. The point guard scored a game-high 14 points on 5-of-11 shooting with two three-pointers in a career-high 36 minutes. Perhaps making his first appearance off the bench in 35 career games stoked his fire. Whatever the reason, it continued the next day with a season-high 16 points in the 83-54 win over Lyndon State, hitting 7-of-12 from the floor with two more triples.

Massive Margin of Victory

By defeating Lyndon State by 29 points, 83-54, on Dec. 13, Dartmouth posted its largest margin of victory since a 96-47 pasting of Plymouth State (that's a 49-point difference) almost one year previously to the day (Dec. 14, 2008). The last time the Big Green beat a Division I opponent by at least 20 points was an 86-62 triumph (24 points) over Maryland Eastern Shore on Jan. 23, 2008. The last time Dartmouth won by 20 against an Ivy opponent? Jan. 30, 1999 when Brown went down, 70-46 (although the Green did beat Princeton two years ago by 19, 71-52).

1,200 and Counting

The 83-54 victory over Lyndon State marked the 1,200th victory in the varsity basketball program's history at Dartmouth. Here are the dates of other milestone victories:

Going Retro with 80s

The 83 points for the Big Green against Lyndon State put them over 80 for the first time since a 96-47 win over Plymouth State last year. It was also just the 10th time in the past seven seasons Dartmouth has reached the 80-point plateau, going 8-2 in those contests.

Weeden Doubles Up

It had been more than a year since a Big Green player had recorded a double-double before **Clive Weeden** provided 11 points and a career-high 11 rebounds at Furman on Nov. 21. Then against Vermont on Dec. 1, the center posted another double-double with a career-best 14 points and 10 boards. Eight of his points came from the line, doubling his previous high.

Dead-Eye Dixon

Although the Big Green fell by five points against Vermont, junior **Ronnie Dixon** had his shots falling nearly every time he put one up. The guard was 5-of-6 from the floor and 1-of-2 from three-point range, plus hit each of his two free throws.

New Career Mark Early and Often

In the first four games this year, sophomore **Josh Riddle** set a new personal mark in scoring three times. First, he scored nine points in the opener, besting every game from his rookie campaign. At Furman, he scored 10 before tallying 11 in the home opener against Loyola. After a scoring slump, he has scored 17 points in the last three games. So the Riddle is when will he get 12 in one game?

Pride of the Big Green

Senior **Robby Pride** led Dartmouth to its first victory of the season by scoring a then-career-high 19 points against Hartford on Nov. 28. He had 12 of the Big Green's first 19 points and finished the night shooting 6-of-9 overall with a trio of treys, another personal best. The next game he shared some of the wealth by dishing out four assists.

Ruffuling the Opponents

Last year, **David Rufful** led the Ivy League with 24 steals in the 14 conference games as a rookie. The sophomore has started the 2009-10 season right where he left off, pilfering the pockets of opponents with four steals at Boston College and three more at New Hampshire and against Colgate each. His average of 1.7 steals per game is tied for fifth in the Ivy League.

Fouls and Free Throws

Dartmouth was whistled for just eight fouls against Hartford, its fewest in over 30 years. The Hawks, meanwhile, committed 23 fouls, many coming in the final minutes of the game, but the Big Green foiled the strategy, scoring their final 13 points of the game from the line and hitting each of their last eight foul shots. Dartmouth hit 20 free throws in the game, just the third time in the last six years that they have made at least that many.

Good to Be Home

Dartmouth began the season with three true road games for just the second time in the past 80 years, dropping all three. The Big Green also had three true road games to open the 1989-90 season, winning two of three. Oddly, both years began with games at Boston College.

Oh Captain my Captain

For the second consecutive year, Dartmouth guard **Robby Pride** is serving as captain. The senior is the 10th player in Big Green history to serve two terms as a captain, while only Bryan Randall '88 was a three-time captain.

Rare Two-Sport Athlete

In addition to **Robby Pride's** duties as the co-captain, the senior is also a member of the lacrosse team at Dartmouth, making him the only Division I male to participate in these two sports. Two years ago he played in 10 games with five starts, scoring one goal and dishing out two assists. Pride played in 10 games again last year, taking three shots while grabbing 15 groundballs.

Post-Grad Teammates

Sophomores **David Rufful** and **Josh Riddle** spent the 2007-08 school year attending Northfield Mt. Hermon prep school and playing hoops together in their post-graduate year. In addition, junior **Clive Weeden** spent three years at the school, but graduated before the pair attended.

Barnett in France Finland

The 2009 Ivy League Player of the Year, **Alex Barnett**, graduated last spring, and after playing five games in the ProA League and another five in the ProB League in France, has joined FoKoPo in the top league in Finland. Barnett averaged 10.6 points and 4.0 rebounds for Hermine Nantes Atlantique in the ProB League, but now is averaging 18.5 points and 7.3 rebounds while shooting 52.4 percent in his first eight games in Finland.

New Hampshire Native

There is only one New Hampshire native currently playing for Dartmouth on the hardwood — men or women. **Kirk Crecco** of Gilford High was the state's Class M Player of the Year in 2007-08, scoring 1,300 points in his high school career. Not only did he help lead his basketball squad to the championship game as a junior, he was a two-time all-state soccer player as well. The soccer squad won the state championship his sophomore year and reached the finals the following season.

Marquis Hall had 17 points — all in the second half — to lead the Mountain Hawks, while six-foot senior Robby Pride led four Dartmouth players in double figures with 13 points while snaring a career-high nine rebounds. Dartmouth freshman center Matt LaBove came off the bench to register his first career double-double with 12 points and a game-high 11 rebounds.

The Big Green fell behind by 20 points in the second half after Hall scored 13 points in a four-minute stretch, part of an 18-6 Mountain Hawk run. Michael Ojo, who finished the game with 14 points, capped the run with a pair of free throws to make it 52-32 with 12:23 remaining.

Pride put Dartmouth on the comeback trail by drilling the first three-pointer for the Green with just under 10 minutes to play. But even with his second triple with seven minutes left, Dartmouth still trailed by 16 at 58-42. That three did start a 9-1 burst, cutting the deficit to 11 with 4:37 left.

Two minutes later, LaBove got the Green within single digits with a short jumper to make it 62-53. And when Griffin rained a three down with 1:07 to play, Dartmouth found itself within six. But Lehigh knocked down each of its last four free throws to keep the Big Green at bay.

David Rufful converted a three-point play with 0.9 seconds remaining to lift host Dartmouth to a thrilling one-point victory over St. Francis (N.Y.) on Monday evening at Leede Arena. Rufful finished the game with 16 points, complementing the career-high 21 poured in by Robby Pride to send the Big Green to the win.

Rufful's finger roll and free throw gave interim head coach Mark Graupe his first Division I triumph as Dartmouth shot 53.7 percent for the game, just the fourth time the Green topped even 40 percent this season.

Dartmouth trailed by as many as six with 2:18 to play and was still down four with just 15 ticks left on the clock. Pride got free from the left wing and drained a three to make it a one-point game at 63-62, then fouled with 8.1 seconds to stop the clock. Unfortunately for the Big Green, it was the fifth foul on Pride, who was 6-of-7 from the floor — hitting all three of his three-pointers — and a perfect 6-of-6 at the line.

Kayode Ayeni, who tallied 15 points on the night, hit the first foul shot but misfired on the second. Rufful snared the rebound, dished off to Jabari Trotter who gave the ball back to Rufful near the top of the key. He drove the lane, getting to the rim and sinking the layup while getting fouled with 0.9 seconds to go. His free throw gave Dartmouth its first lead in over 10 minutes, and St. Francis failed to get a shot off before the buzzer.

Both Jeremy Lin and Kyle Casey tallied 19 points for visiting Harvard, with Casey grabbing 10 rebounds for a double-double, to help the Crimson fend off Dartmouth. The Big Green had three players in double figures, led by Ronnie Dixon with a season-high 15 points.

The Dartmouth defense held a Harvard squad among the top 10 nationally in field goal percentage to just 39 percent (23-of-59) from the floor and a paltry 11.8 percent (2-of-17) from three-point range. The Crimson, among the top 10 in free throw percentage as well, were shaky at the foul line as well, making just 14-of-26 (.538).

The game began quite well for the Big Green as they tallied 13 straight points after Harvard opened the game with a bucket. But Dartmouth eventually trailed by as many as 13 with seven minutes to play, and found themselves still behind by 10 with 1:21 on the clock. Dixon drained his last of three triples, and after the Crimson converted just 1-of-2 at the line, Trotter sank a long jumper with his toe on the arc to get Dartmouth within six.

Pride countered three Harvard free throws with two layups, making it a five-point game, and when Trotter drilled a three-pointer, the Green trailed by only three with 17 ticks on the clock. The Crimson managed to convert only one free throw, but it was enough as two Dartmouth three-point attempts were off the mark before the buzzer sounded.
