THIS WEEKEND

For the second weekend in a row, Dartmouth women's hockey will travel to the Empire State, this time taking on No. 6/6 Cornell and No. 4/4 Colgate in some ECAC Hockey play. Both games will be played at 3 p.m.

LAST TIME OUT

The Big Green had a great weekend on the road, going 1-0-1 and earning three points to move up a spot in the conference standings.

Dartmouth at Union

Caroline Shaunessy and Christina Rombaut had two points apiece in the 3-2 victory over the Dutchwomen on Friday. Shaunessy netted the Green's first and third goals, while Rombaut opened scoring in the first and assisted on the game-winning tally. Morgan Turner, Alyssa Baker, Kate Landers and Sydney Hill all had an assist. Christine Honor had a good game in net, making 25 saves to earn the win.

Union controlled the early parts of the first period and, following three Dartmouth penalties in a short amount of time, had a 1-0 advantage. The Big Green soon turned the game around, finding the back of the net twice in less than three minutes to take the lead. Rombaut tied things up with her second of the season at 12:16, while Shaunessy put Dartmouth ahead with her power-play tally at 14:57.

The Green's lead did not last long, as the Dutchwomen responded just 37 seconds into the second to make it a 2-2 game. With both team's defense on point, it took until the 15th minute for the tie to be broken. Rombaut had a great breakaway opportunity, but was stopped by netminder Coco Francis. Unfortunately for Francis, the puck rebounded to Shaunessy, who fired past the diving goalie for the second time to score the eventual game winner.

After a combined five goals were scored in the first two periods, the third was a

lot quieter, although not devoid of action by any means. Union had a 13-11 shot advantage, but smart plays by the Big Green kept the Dutchwomen out of the net. Late in the period, Honor had two great back-to-back saves, diving on the puck to get Dartmouth out of danger.

Dartmouth at RPI

Thanks to a goal scored late in the third by Linda Essery, Dartmouth skated to a 3-3 tie against Rensselaer on Saturday. Baker and Rombaut led the team with two points, while Essery, Jennifer Costa, Megan Cornell, Hailey Noronha and Turner all had a point. Honor had another great game and ended up with 42 saves and a .933 save percentage.

The first period was filled with aggressive, back-and-forth action, but not many true scoring opportunities. RPI's best chances came in the 17th minute, when the Engineers got five straight shots off. Good defense and four quick saves by Honor kept the puck out of the net and the game tied at 0-0.

After almost half an hour of scoreless play, Dartmouth broke through first. At 7:57, just 18 seconds into the power play, Noronha's shot from the blue line was redirected into the left corner of the net by Baker to put the Green up, 1-0. It became a two-goal game at 14:38 when Baker swung around the net and passed to Cornell waiting in the crease, sending it over Lovisa Selander's left shoulder. Twenty-two seconds later, the Engineers got one back to make it a slightly closer game (2-1).

RPI controlled the start of the third period, tying the game up at 3:55 and taking the lead for the first time at 8:32. At 16:51,

Essery netted her second tally of the season, taking advantage of Selander losing sight of the puck and shooting to the left while the goalie covered her right. Little happened in the remaining three minutes and the teams headed to overtime.

Both teams had a few opportunities to end things early during the five-minute overtime period, but Honor and Selander were on their game and denied everything that was sent their way. The Big Green outshot the Engineers, 3-2, in the extra period.

SCOUTING THE BIG RED

After dropping three games in a row, Cornell rebounded on Tuesday with a 6-3 win over Syracuse thanks to a short-handed goal by Kristin O'Neill with 20 seconds to go in the contest. The Big Red have done well so far in ECAC Hockey games and are currently sixth with a 6-4-0 mark. Just two players have made it to double-digit points, and the team is led by O'Neill with her 19 points (7G, 12A).

LAST TIME AGAINST CORNELL

The Big Red is just one of four conference teams that the Big Green have not yet faced in 2017-18. Last season, Dartmouth had a pair of one-goal losses to Cornell. Almost a year ago, the Green fell to eight-ranked Cornell, 1-0, at Thompson Arena.

Robyn Chemago played a good game between the pipes, making a number of huge saves to keep Dartmouth in the game, stopping 28 in all. Tess Bracken led the team with three shots.

SCOUTING THE RAIDERS

Colgate has had a great season so far, suffering just three losses in its 21 games. Before its game against Harvard on Friday, Colgate enters the weekend on a four-game unbeaten streak, taking down Cornell (5-4), Quinnipiac (2-1, OT) and Princeton (3-2) and tying Robert Morris (3-3). The Raiders are tied for first in the ECAC Hockey with a record of 8-2-0. Leading the team with 10 goals and 10 assists each are Jessie Eldridge and Shae Labbe.

LAST TIME AGAINST COLGATE

The Big Green went 0-2 against the Raiders in 2016-17. At home on Jan. 28, Kennedy Ottenbreit scored halfway through the third period, with assists going to Rombaut and Shaunessy, in

Dartmouth's 6-1 loss to Colgate.

AND IN NET

Honor has been having a pretty good year so far, starting all but one of the team's 15 games. In 754 minutes, she has made 436 saves while allowing 43 goals and has a .910 save percentage and 3.42 goals against average. She has had over 35 saves in seven games and over 40 in three. Shannon Ropp has played in four games and got her first career start and collegiate win against Holy Cross. In 146 minutes, she has made 71 saves while allowing nine goals, has an .888 save percentage and 3.69 goals against average. Dartmouth's third netminder, Kayla Wormsbecher, has not yet seen any playing time.

COACHES CORNER



It was announced in June 2017 that Joe Marsh will serve as the Dartmouth women's hockey interim head coach for the 2017-18 season while Laura Schuler assumes head coaching responsibilities for the Canadian Olympic Team.

Marsh is the former longtime head coach of the St. Lawrence men's hockey team, guiding the Saints from behind the bench for 27 years from 1985 through 2012. During his time in Canton, Marsh amassed a program-record 482 wins with two regular season ECAC Hockey titles and five tournament championships. In both 1988 and 2000, Marsh led the Saints to the NCAA's Frozen Four, taking his team to the national title game in the former. In all, the 1977 UNH graduate guided SLU to eight NCAA Tournament appearances.

The two-time National Coach of the Year (1989 and 2000), Marsh was also tabbed as the recipient of the Tim Taylor Award as ECAC Hockey's top coach four times during his career (1989, 1992, 2000 and 2001), the most in league history.

"I'm excited to step in and help Laura's program," Marsh said. I'm coming into a program that Laura and her staff are continuing to establish on a national level. Philosophically, we are on the same page.

"The transition should be easy because of how well she has built and organized this program in her time here," Marsh continued.

Marsh will fill in for Schuler who has the honor to serve as the Canadian Women's National Team Head Coach once again. Schuler's responsibilities with Team Canada will take her away from Hanover for the season as she looks to guide her team to a fifth straight Olympic Gold Medal in PyeongChang, South Korea, in February.

"It's really exciting to have someone of Joe's caliber, experience and character step in," Schuler remarked. "There is no doubt he will help to take our team in a positive direction.

"Joe and I spent a lot of time talking about our team's vision, direction and plan," she continued. "It was evident this will be a smooth transition and I felt that both he and I were on the same page."



Chris Cobb is in his second season with the Dartmouth women's hockey team.

Cobb comes to Dartmouth from ECAC Hockey rival Union, where he served as an assistant coach for the 2015-16 season. While

in Schenectady, Cobb was responsible for recruiting prospective athletes, managing the forwards, pre-scouting opponents, video breakdown for individual and team use and conducting skills sessions.

Prior to that, he spent three seasons at Williams, helping lead the Ephs to a NESCAC title and an appearance in the NCAA Elite Eight. During his tenure, he was responsible for recruiting, video breakdown and managing the defense and goalies. He coached two first-team All-Americans, three first-team and one second-team All-NESCAC award winners, one NESCAC Player of the Year and one NESCAC Rookie of the Year.

Before Williams, Cobb spent five years as the head coach at UMass Amherst and three seasons as an assistant coach at Amherst. At UMass, his teams went 68-48-13 in five seasons and had five ACHA national tournament appearances, three ECWHL Championship game appearances, and two ACHA Final Four appearances. At Amherst, Cobb's primary responsibility was coaching the goalies. The program went 63-14-7 in his three seasons, including two NCAA appearances, and three NESCAC championship game appearances, winning the 2010 NESCAC and NCAA Division III National Championship.

Cobb has also spent time as the assistant coach of the ACHA women's national team, coaching the squad on a tour of Europe playing games against various professional teams. Cobb received his bachelor of science in kinesiology from UMass in 2007 before going on to receive his master's in coaching education from Ohio University.

A 2015 Dartmouth graduate and a former alternate captain, Illikainen returns to Hanover after spending a

season as the hockey and lacrosse assistant at the Northwood School in Lake Placid, New York.

While at Northwood (2016-17), she assisted with planning, organizing and instructing all on-ice practices and lifts, working mostly with the defensive core unit. In addition, she helped with recruiting and had an active role in admission decisions. She also worked with the lacrosse team throughout the 2017 season.

Illikainen's time away from the rink and the lacrosse field was spent in the classroom, as she served as the world history teacher. She was responsible for all facets of planning, organizing and instructing daily history lessons to sophomores.

Illikainen graduated from Dartmouth with a degree in psychology and government. While wearing a green and white uniform, she appeared in 112 games. Her most successful season was her final year, scoring four goals and tacking on seven assists for a career-high 11 points. She also had three power play goals and the game winner against Northeastern on New Year's Eve.
